ABOUT

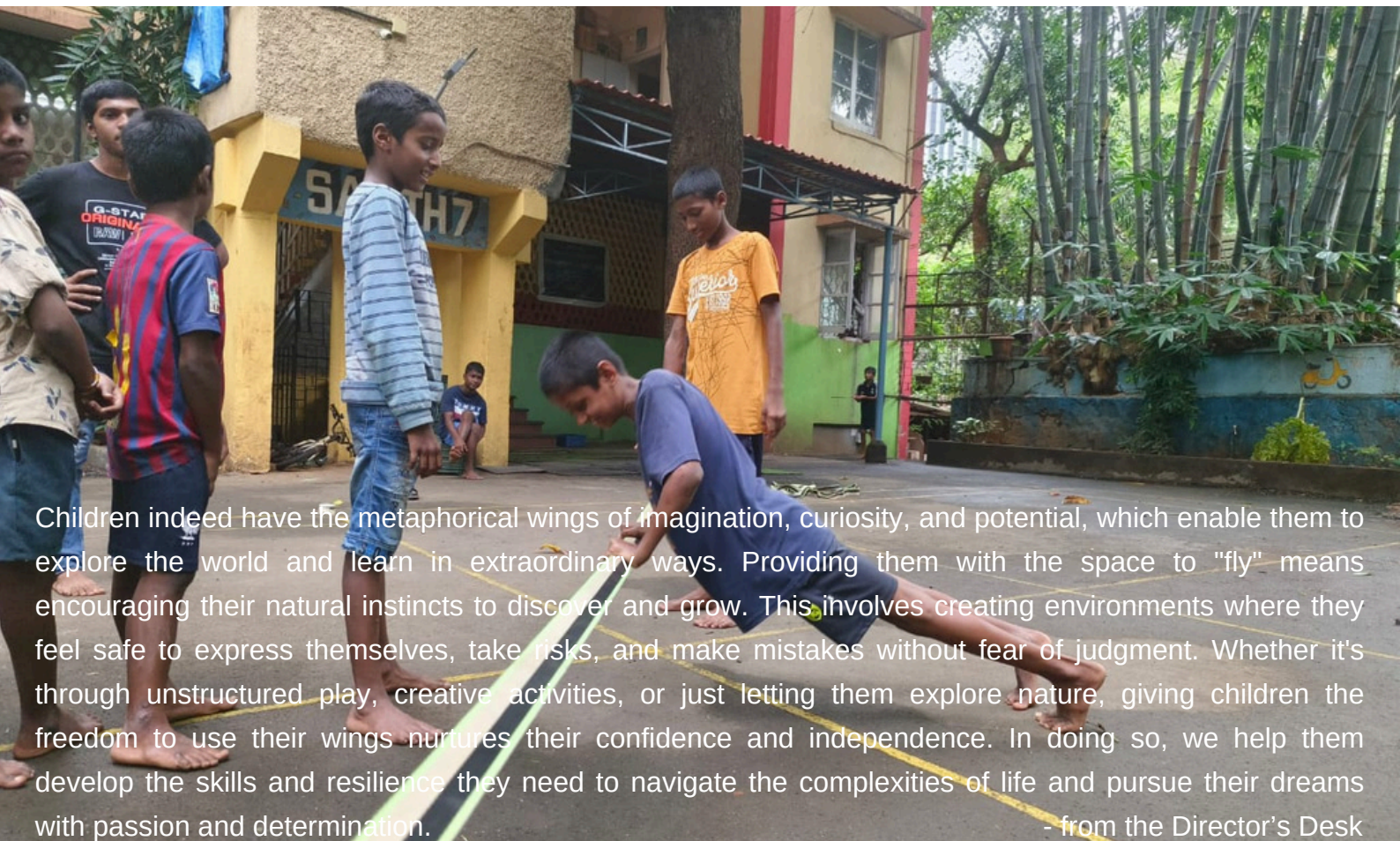
Snehasadan is a non-governmental organization based in Mumbai, India, dedicated to providing a home and future for homeless street children. Over the past 62 years, Snehasadan has provided shelter to over 30,000 children, helping them escape life on the streets and gain access to shelter, education, and a supportive family environment.

MISSION

To be a home for homeless children, regardless of caste or creed, provide a shelter for the homeless orphans, waifs, destitute and delinquents, economically poor and socially discriminated, who roam almost every quarter of Mumbai.

AIM

Snehasadan's aim is to reach out to the homeless children, find out what were the reasons for which they are on the streets, trace their families and reunite them with their families wherever possible. Where family tracing is not possible, or the children are orphans, Snehasadan becomes their home and provides them with the environment for holistic growth and development.

Providing them with the space to "fly" means encouraging their natural instincts to discover and grow. 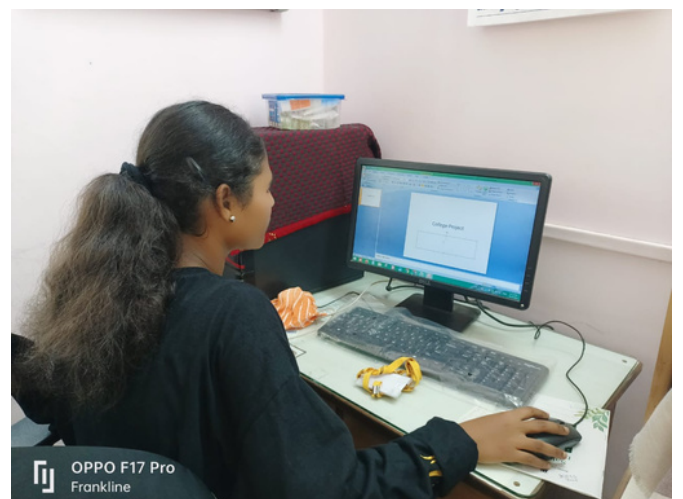

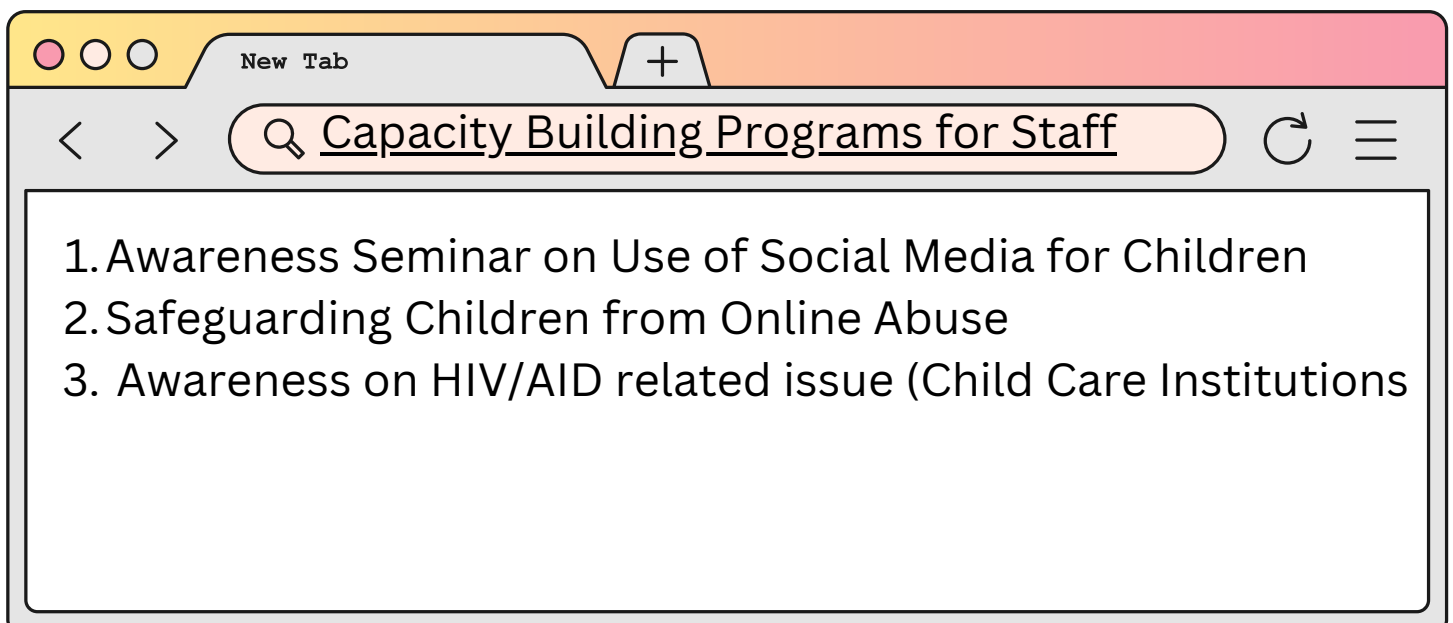


Digital Learning (MS-CIT certification)
